## Construction Update

Several construction projects at Asheville Regional Airport are in the final phases, including the baggage claim reconstruction project (pictured right) and ticketing office renovations. These projects, as well as our new Guest Services Center, will be unveiled in early 2009.

Phase I of Runway Rehabilitation begins this month and will continue through Spring, 2009. The runway project involves pavement and lighting evaluation to ensure safety and compliance.

For the General Aviation enthusiast, a new Fixed-Base Operator (FBO), Landmark, will begin Phase 1 of its construction this week. As part of the North General Aviation Expansion Project, the new FBO plans to be operational by Spring of 2009, with the remainder of the project slated for completion in 12-18 months.

Additionally, crews broke ground on a new aircraft storage hangar for FBO Million Air this week.
