TSA Travel Tips

As you prepare for upcoming travel, don't forget these tips:

- 1)** The 3-1-1. For your carry-on bags, limit liquids and gels to **3 - ounce** or smaller containers; pack these containers into a **1-quart** plastic zip-top bag; **1 bag** per passenger is allowed.
- 2)** To save time as you pass through the security check-point, wear shoes that are easy to take off and put back on. Wearing little or no metal accessories, such as jewelry, belt buckles, or shoes with metal, will also make your travel experience easier.
- 3)** Unless you're going to consume it before you reach the security check-point, wait until you've reached the secure side of the airport before buying a bottle of water, soda or other liquid.
