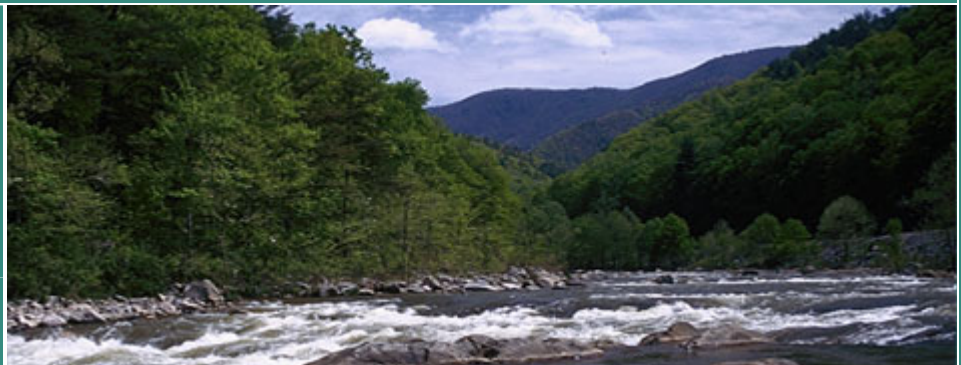

Parking at Asheville Regional Airport is easy!

Long Term

If your travels will be more than 24 hours, plan to park in Long Term Parking for only \$7.00 per 24 hours.

Short Term

If your vehicle will be parked for less than 24 hours, follow the signs to Short Term Parking, where the first 20 minutes are free and one hour is just \$2.00.

New Boarding Ramps Unveiled at AVL

The Asheville Regional Airport Authority unveiled new Regional Boarding ramps (RBRs) and B-Gate improvements last Friday. The

\$1.3 million project was constructed over the past year and will serve to upgrade the boarding process for passengers.

"These improvements to the airport enhance the passenger experience," says David N. Edwards, Jr., A.A.E., "The RBRs keep travelers out of the weather elements and improve the security on our ramp."

The three RBRs will initially be used to support US Airways and Delta Air Lines passengers flying on Regional Jet and Dehaviland Dash-8 aircraft. Passengers flying on the ATR (tail-loading aircraft) will still have to walk outside to board due to the aircraft configuration, although Delta Air Lines has indicated that all ATRs will be replaced by RBR-compatible aircraft within the next several months.

Passengers checking bags at the gate will also find a more convenient way to turn their luggage over to the carriers for transport in the form of new luggage carts. The carts also make it easier for the airline personnel to keep the bags clean and dry.

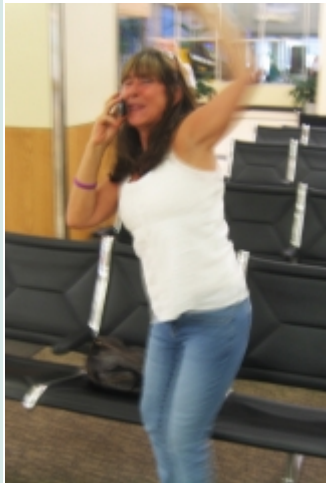
