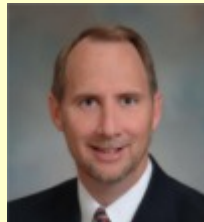

New Aircraft Rescue Fire Fighting Vehicle Unveiled



The Asheville Regional Airport Authority added a new Aircraft Rescue Fire Fighting (ARFF) vehicle to its Department of Public Safety (DPS) fleet. The new technology of this fire apparatus allows DPS officers to actively combat running fuel fires. The ARFF is also outfitted with an infrared system to detect residual heat and hot spots and help direct firefighting efforts.

Additional features built into the ARFF include:

- Telescoping light tower for on-scene lighting
- Integrated communication capabilities
- Full-color safety camera to record operations
- Several twin-agent turrets to battle fires more effectively by combining water and dry chemicals
- The ability to extinguish fires at a rate of 1,950 gallons per minute from a 1500 gallon tank

The \$742,000 truck brings a new level of readiness to the Department of Public Safety and the airport as a whole. "The operational technology of this vehicle will enable our Department of Public Safety to more effectively handle the unlikely event of an emergency situation," says David N. Edwards, Jr., Airport Director. "We purchase these vehicles to enhance our passengers' safety, but with the hope we'll never have to use them."

DPS is responsible for providing 24-hour ARFF and police services, along with emergency medical care, to all who utilize the Asheville Regional Airport.
